

PUBLIC NOTICE
PROPOSED CONSENT ORDER

The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) and the Raymond Croxford dba Knollwood Mobile Home Park (Defendant) have entered into a Consent Order to resolve allegations of violations of Ohio Revised Code (R.C.) Chapter 6111. The complaint was filed by the State of Ohio in the Athens County Court of Common Pleas. Under the proposed Consent Order, Defendant is permanently enjoined and immediately ordered to comply with the requirements of R.C. 6111 and rules adopted thereunder, and the terms and conditions of its expired National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit No.0PV00007*FD until a new permit is issued. Specifically, Defendant is enjoined to immediately submit a NPDES permit application, hire and maintain a properly certified operator to oversee the waste water treatment plant, submit a Permit to Install application for the installation of a disinfection system, and hire a consultant to evaluate the waste water treatment plant. Also, the proposed Consent Order stipulates that the Defendant will pay a civil penalty of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

Written comments should be submitted to Ohio EPA, Southeast District Office at the above address. Written Comments should be submitted on or before March 1, 2011.

The final approval and entry of the proposed Consent Order will not occur until after the thirty (30) day public comment period has expired. The thirty day period commences on January 31, 2011. Both the State of Ohio and Raymond Croxford reserve the right to withdraw or alter the proposed Consent Order based on comments received during the public comment period.
