Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA)–Division of Surface Water (DSW) has issued a draft renewal of the general National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for discharges of petroleum related corrective actions in the state of Ohio.

Applicants under this permit include facilities discharging wastewater from petroleum-related corrective actions to a receiving stream. “Petroleum-related Corrective Actions” are defined as ground and/or surface water from remediation systems; surface and/or ground water accumulating as a result of excavation activity; surface water and ground water contaminated by spills, or ground water resulting from pumping and/or monitoring aquifers.

All of these discharges are resulting from any corrective actions involving aboveground or underground storage tanks used to store gasoline, diesel fuel, kerosene, jet fuel, or heating oil, or the transportation of these materials.

This permit would be a renewal of coverage for dischargers under OHU00004 – coverage granted after January 1, 2006

New dischargers covered by this permit are considered degradations under Ohio’s Antidegradation Rule [OAC Rule 3745-1-05], because they permit discharges of pollutants that may not currently be reaching surface waters of the state. As dischargers under this permit are clean-ups of groundwater from response action sites, they are excluded from the alternatives analysis and socio-economic justification requirements of this rule [OAC Rule 3745-1-05(D)(1)(d)].

The public hearing will end when everyone in attendance has had an opportunity to provide testimony related to the draft permit.
