Re: Petroleum-Related Corrective Actions General Permit  
Renewal

Dear General Permit Holder:

Ohio EPA has finalized the renewal of the general permit for petroleum-related corrective actions (permit # OHU000005). The effective date for the permit is **February 1, 2011** and the expiration date is **January 31, 2016**. Permittees that currently have coverage under the petroleum-related corrective actions (PRCA) general permit must submit a new notice of intent (NOI) within 45 days of the effective date (or no later than **March 17, 2011**) in order to continue coverage under the permit. If you have already submitted an NOI for continuing coverage, this requirement has been satisfied.

There have been some additions to the new permit, most notably effluent limits for lead which are based upon the watershed where the discharge occurs. As you complete the NOI for continuing coverage, please note that you must select the appropriate effluent table for your permit coverage by reviewing the list of watersheds applicable to each table.
