

**NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF RULES
OHIO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY**

Rules Governing

Wastewater Permitting Program

Notice is hereby given that the Director of Environmental Protection, in accordance with Chapter 119 of the Revised Code, has adopted the following rules of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). Authority to adopt OAC Chapter 3745-1 rules is under Section 6111.041 of the Ohio Revised Code. Authority to adopt OAC Chapter 3745-2 rules is under Sections 6111.03 and 6111.12 of the Ohio Revised Code. Authority to adopt OAC Chapter 3745-33 rules is under Sections 6111.03, 6111.031, and 6111.13 of the Ohio Revised Code.

The Director's action in this matter is pursuant to the procedural requirements of Ohio Revised Code Chapter 119 and is based upon the record of the public hearing conducted by Ohio EPA on January 6, 2011, and comments received during the public comment period.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00, made payable to "Ohio Treasurer Josh Mandel," which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit you demonstrate that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section.
