We worry about distracted drivers and car safety ratings, but your own home might be more dangerous than the busy streets. **Prescription drug overdose is now the leading cause of accidental death** in the U.S., surpassing car crashes.

IS YOUR HOME SAFE?

Leftover prescription medications can be a problem. The Worthington Division of Police has a solution: a prescription drug drop box.

You can now **drop off your unwanted prescription medications 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, in the lobby of police headquarters:**

ACCEPTING pills and patches of:

- expired and unused medications
- medication samples
- pet medications

Simply place your unwanted medications in a container and drop it in the box. Please do not bring loose medications, needles, lancets, syringes, inhalers or liquids.

This permanent medication disposal box is available to the community through a partnership with the National Association of Drug Diversion Investigators, Inc., *Drug Safe Worthington* and the Worthington Division of Police.
