

Public Notice – Request for Comment
Draft Review of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rules
OAC Chapter 3745-76, “Control of Non-Methane Organic Emissions
from Existing Landfills”

Notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, Division of Air Pollution Control (DAPC) reviewed the rules contained in Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Chapter 3745-76. The rules are related to the requirements for the control of non-methane organic compound (NMOC) emissions from existing landfills. The review determined that the rules in OAC Chapter 3745-76 need to be amended and/or rescinded in order to conform to the revised federal regulations for existing solid waste landfills.

As part of the rule-making process, DAPC is required by Section 121.39 of the Ohio Revised Code to consult with organizations that represent political subdivisions, environmental interests, business interests, and others affected by the rules. The DAPC is offering your organization the opportunity to comment on these rules before the division formally proposes them.
